The Grand River Agricultural Society Bursary and Scholarship Program F2019

The following are the criteria for the Society Bursary/Scholarship Program:

- 1. The student must be a permanent resident within our membership area of Wellington County, Perth County and the Region of Waterloo.
- 2. The applicant must be pursuing studies in an agriculturally and/or environmentally related program and provide evidence of acceptance into such program.
- 3. The applicant must have a proven record of involvement in the school and the community showing interest in the field of agriculture or the environment.
- 4. Preference will be given to those applicants that demonstrate consistent academic achievement
- 5. Applicants applying for a bursary must clearly demonstrate financial need.

Please Note:

- 1. Incomplete or inaccurate applications will not be considered (SIN <u>must</u> be provided for tax purposes)
- 2. Transcripts must be official (original, stamped photocopies or a letter of validation from the school.) Computer print-outs will not be accepted.
- 3. By completing and submitting the application, all scholarship/bursary recipients agree to give the Grand River Agricultural Society permission to post/publish the recipient's photo and/or name.
